### Event Rules

1. All Live cattle offered at auction must be registered with the ACA.
2. All Breeding cattle selling do so with the guarantee to be breeders.
3. Sale management reserves the right to limit consignment numbers.
4. Sale management and sale committee reserves the right to screen any entries on quality from the sale that are deemed unfit.
5. All tied cattle must be broke to lead.
6. Cows or bred females being offered as "Pinned or un-haltered " cattle are welcome, however they must be gentle and easy to handle.
7. Individual interstate health certificates must accompany each lot consigned. Consignors and their veterinarian are solely responsible to make certain all tests that are required by state and federal laws are conducted prior to issuing a health certificate.
8. This is a self-supporting sale with sale expenses deducted from each lot offered for sale as a percentage of total gross sales expenses. Commission will be paid on no sales, and settlement will be required before release will be authorized. Settlement to consignors will be mailed in a prompt manner.
9. Show will establish a sale order and serve as a parade of the sale offering. Classes will be split on age. With no more than 6 per class and only placing the top two in each class.
10. Premium monies and matching funds from the Dept of Ag will be distributed to the top placing animals. Premium monies will be sent with settlement checks.
11. All cattle must show to sell at auction and conversely all cattle that show must be offered in the auction.
12. All consignors do agree to abide by the event rules and all decisions a by sale management and/or sale committee.
13. Nominating fee must accompany entry forms. Fees are \$100 per live lot and \$25 per frozen genetic. For each event nomination fees will be applied to gross sale expenses.
14. The sale management reserves the right to edit all footnotes and will make judgments on lot number assignments and photo usage.
15. Registration certificate must accompany the animal at check in and will be transferred to the new owner at the sellers expense.
16. Entry fee is non-refundable.
17. Substitutions allowed with the permission of the sale manager.
18. No cattle will be listed in the sale catalog without receipt of entry fees.
19. Cattle consigned to this event remain the property of the owner until sold. Neither the sale management, auctioneer, sale staff, sale committee or other representatives shall assume any liability and will be held harmless by owner for any damages resulting in any loss, damage, claim, injury or cause of actions as the result of this sale.

When entries are received you will receive a conformation letter with a detailed event schedule.
